V. Description of the project

- a. The District is seeking bids for the inspection, testing, maintenance and repair of fire protection sprinklers, and for the inventory and flow testing of fire hydrants. See Appendix A, Specifications, for full description of requirements.
- b. Work hours are Monday through Friday, 7:00 am 7:00 pm
- c. Contractor shall contact the head custodian to schedule work 24 hours prior to the service. See Appendix A, Head Custodians, for contact information.
- VI. **Basis of Award** The District intends to award a three (3) year contract with the option to extend for two (2) additional one (1) year terms, for a maximum five (5) year term, to the Contractor offering the lowest, responsible bid, meeting District specifications.
- VII. References to "Owner" and "District" shall be the Corona-Norco Unified School District.

SCOPE OF WORK

Bidding contractors will be responsible for providing fire protection sprinkler inspection, testing, maintenance and repairs designed to maximize performance, safety, and life span of the District's fire protection systems for the District's locations referenced below and any other facilities as requested by authorized District personnel. Bidding contractors will also be responsible for the inspection and testing of District fire hydrants.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CONTRACTOR


- 1. Contractor shall provide two (2) scheduled preventative maintenance services during the year which shall consist of 100% mechanical and electrical inspection of all kitchen suppression systems to include the fire extinguishers for each suppression system.
- 2. All inspections, testing, maintenance and repairs must comply with all District, State of California and Federal regulations for this type of service(s) as well as those of the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 25, or the latest edition of each, Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and manufacturers' recommended procedure, as applicable.
- 3. Emergency requests for service shall be responded to within a two (2) hour period, twenty-four (24) hours a day.
- 4. Contractor shall attach a maintenance testing tag to each fire suppression system with the inspector's initials, date, and confirmation on maintenance/inspections performed.
- 5. Fusible links shall be changed semi-annually.
 - a. Where fusible links are used, the manufacture and installation dates for the links shall be marked on the system inspection tab.
- 6. A signed and dated log of maintenance and a certificate showing date of system inspection of cleaning, testing, maintenance and/or repair shall be available in the District's Support Services Field Supervisor.
- 7. Wet chemical fire-extinguishing system shall comply with standard Underwriter's Laboratories (UL) 300.
- 8. If repairs are needed, the contractor shall provide an estimate of repairs prior to servicing the system to the District's Support Services Field Supervisor.
 - a. Estimates shall be signed by designated department representative prior to completion of work.
- 9. Contractor shall furnish labor and materials for any repairs.
- 10. Unit price shall include a flat rate amount for services specified including the cost of labor, direct and indirect costs, travel, fuel, delivery of items needing repair.
- 11. Fuel surcharges or any other charges are NOT acceptable for this service.
- 12. Contractor shall not be allowed to bill an additional trip charge to retrieve the needed materials, supplies, equipment and parts that are needed for repairs.
- 13. If required as a result of a test, inspection or service call any device indicating trouble shall be repaired and/or adjusted for proper operation. Once an inspection repair is complete, contractor may not charge an additional fee for re-inspection.
- 14. Any invoices that are presented for payment, that do not have a work order signed by an authorized District representative, will not be paid by the District.
- 15. All parts replaced must be UL approved.
- 16. If equipment requires parts/replacement, it shall be at District's expense.
- 17. Contractor shall obtain all applicable permit(s) and inspection(s) necessary for completion of repairs.
- 18. Sufficient amounts of spare parts for all systems shall be maintained at all times by the contractor to prevent an extended shutdown due to the malfunction of the systems.

EXAMINATION OF THE EQUIPMENT AND SITES

- 1. The contractor shall take all precautions to protect the District's property from injury and be held responsible for all employees or any person or persons, instruments or devices directly or indirectly employed by him.
- 2. Any corresponding damages shall be replaced, repaired, and paid for by the Contractor to the satisfaction of all parties
